

AREA 6 - GUILFORD/KERNWOOD/LOYOLA RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING PROGRAM FOR 2008/2009

Baltimore City has designated certain parking areas in our community for the exclusive use of residents. Signs are posted in these areas, and participating blocks are listed on the back of this notice. In order to park in these areas, residents must obtain and display a special permit that can be obtained from the City.

WHEN TO APPLY: Residents who are new to the program may apply at any time. Residents who are current permit holders must apply to renew their permits between July 1, 2008 and August 15, 2008.

WHERE TO APPLY: Residents should apply online, following the instructions below. Alternatively, residents may call (443) 573-2800 and request that an application be sent to them.

HOW TO APPLY ONLINE: Type the following address in your internet browser:
<http://www.baltimorecity.gov/government/parking/permits.php>. Next, click on "ONLINE RESIDENTIAL PARKING APPLICATION," which appears under the heading "Residential Parking." Once you reach the Parking Authority page, new participants should sign up for a user name and password by clicking on "Sign up here!" in the brown box on the right; if you are renewing your permit simply follow the instructions under "RENEWALS" in the pink box.

Carefully follow the instructions on the website. New participants will need to provide their current MVA vehicle registration and MVA driver's license information when applying. Renewals must update their vehicle registration and/or driver's license expiration dates.

Please note: Your vehicle registration must be in your name and reflect a correct address in one of the participating blocks. If the vehicle registration is not in your name, you will need a notarized letter from the owner stating you are the sole driver. If it does not reflect a correct address in one of the participating blocks, you will require a proof of residency such as a current lease, utility bill, or invoice for cable or residential telephone service. Students and members of the military must have a current ID. If the vehicle registration is out-of-state and you do not have a Maryland driver's license, you must obtain a non-resident permit from the MVA. COST: The annual fee for each permit is \$20 and is payable by credit card when applying online. Alternatively, payment can be made with a check or money order payable to the "Director of Finance" and mailed with a copy of your application to:

WHEN AND WHERE TO GET YOUR ACTUAL PERMIT: Residents who apply and pay as described above between July 1 and August 15 may pick-up their permits between 1:00 pm and 3:00 pm on Sunday, August 24, 2008 at the Bedford Place bus stop, just south of the Charles Street and St. Paul Street divide OR at the Parking Authority at the above address after August 24, 2008 during regular business hours. Residents who apply and pay at other times of the year must pick-up their permit at the Parking Authority. When you pick-up your permit, you MUST show: (1) proof of payment of the annual fee, (2) your current vehicle registration card(s), and (3) your current driver's license.
