



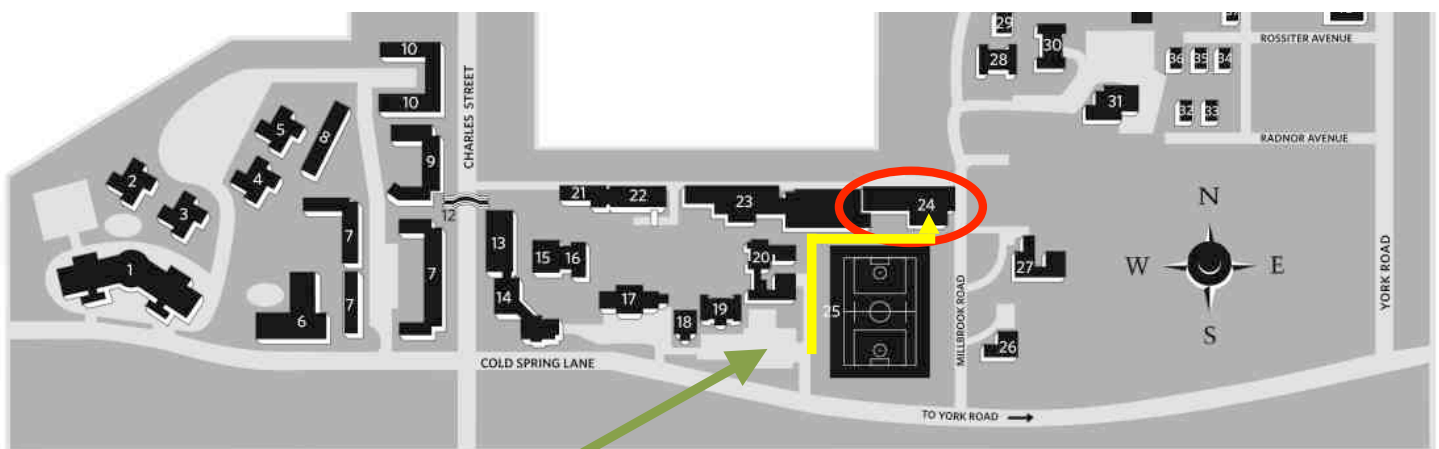
Directions to a

Purpose of the Meeting

The City of Baltimore is continuing a program to comply with a 2006 U.S. Environmental Protection Agency mandate to mitigate the risk of contamination to uncovered finished (drinking) water reservoirs throughout the Baltimore Metropolitan Water System.

EPA ruled that uncovered finished water reservoirs like Guilford pose a health risk due to their vulnerability to contamination and ordered reservoirs to be covered or that their discharge be treated.

This meeting is to share a recommendation by engineers about the most appropriate way to bring the Guilford Reservoir into compliance with federal law.
